



Accelerated Hydrogen Peroxide (AHP)

(Product names include Viper, Virox, Accel)

These are only general guidelines; it is important that you always read and follow the product label. If you have specific questions about your product, please contact your supplier or Public Health Inspector.

Cleaning

Spray disinfectant and wipe on hard surfaces (tables, counters, chairs, doorknobs, other high touch areas).

Disinfecting

Surfaces must be cleaned prior to disinfecting.

Hard surfaces (tables, counter tops, etc.)

- Spray the disinfectant on the surface and let it sit for the contact time listed on the product label (usually about 5 minutes).
- Wipe with a clean wet cloth where children are eating (tables) or on food contact surfaces if the product label indicates it can be used on food contact surfaces.

Hard Toys

- Spray the disinfectant and let the toys air dry.

This product is not approved for items to sit in the liquid. There are Accelerated Hydrogen Peroxide products available that are designed for items to soak in the liquid.

This product is not for use on soft toys – these items must be washed in a washing machine.
