Protect Your Vaccines – Protect Your Patients

- Vaccines must be maintained at temperatures between +2 °C and +8 °C.
- Monitor and document current, maximum and minimum refrigerator temperatures twice daily (including the time the temperature was taken).
- Call your public health unit immediately to report any vaccines that have been exposed to temperatures below $+2 \,^{\circ}$ C and/or above $+8 \,^{\circ}$ C.
- Never administer or discard exposed vaccine until your public health unit has assessed the situation.
